## **Payment Policies**

<u>TUITION IS NOT REFUNDABLE</u>. Students who miss class or withdraw before the end of the Absolute Beginner Ballet 8-week session are still obligated for the full session's tuition. Credit cannot be given for missed classes. Students are eligible for pro-rated tuition refund only if they withdraw from classes due to a prolonged illness or severe injury, and if verified by a doctor's certificate.

<u>CANCELLATION</u>. If you intend on withdrawing from class, then you must notify BRT in writing one week prior to the start of the session. If written notice has not been received by a week prior to the start of the session, the student will still be considered enrolled and obligated for the full 8-week session tuition. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS.

<u>LATE FEE</u>. A 10% late fee will be applied to all tuition not paid by the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of the session. Students with outstanding accounts (after the second class) will not be allowed to take class until the account balance has been paid.

NO REFUNDS / REDUCTIONS. No refunds or reductions will be made for classes missed in the session. Classes cancelled by BRT due to hazardous weather conditions or any other reason will be rescheduled.

<u>SERVICE CHARGE</u>. BRT will add a \$30.00 service charge to the student's account for any returned checks. Any additional charges that BRT may incur as the result of a returned check will also be charged to the student's account.
